I was quite amazed that she actually had the desire to serve in the worship team as all this while, she had always preferred to keep a very low profile and has never expressed her desire to serve God in any way, let alone the worship ministry.

One thing led to another and she started to pluck up her courage to go forward for altar call for a couple of Sundays, something which she had resisted strongly ever since she stepped into TCC. During the Watchnight service on 31 December, she went forward for prayer and this time, she couldn't resist and fell under the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit. In the process, she let out a soft wail which came from deep within and tears just rolled down. Thanks be to God for touching and healing her. It all started with the Father Me Re-Parenting program which has proven to be a very effective and powerful tool for deep emotional healing. All glory to Him!

I believe the Holy Spirit Retreat had also impacted her in the process some way or the other that has led to such unction of the Holy Spirit in playing the drum which was so awesome that Ps Marie Gordon thought that she had been playing the drum for years.

Even during the Watchnight service, God used her mightily to bring His glory down through the drums and we all were overwhelmed at the awesome Presence of God that night even without the help of the other instruments. God has indeed touched her at last.
